

STARWOOD DOG POLICY

Starwood Homeowners are welcome to own household dogs and cats. However, the Starwood Boards remind homeowners that, within its County Code, Pitkin County has established specific rules and regulations regarding dogs running at large. Starwood does not have a special policy on this matter, but relies on Pitkin County's Code that makes it unlawful for animals to run at large or to harass or harm people, other pets or wildlife. The Board believes that most Starwood homeowners with pets already follow Pitkin County's leash requirement when walking on roads around the Starwood neighborhood, which is meant to protect dogs from potential car and truck accidents. The County's laws seem sufficient and require no further enhancement within Starwood. However, the Board does request that dogs be kept on leashes when not on one's own property. If there is an incident with a dog, homeowners are encouraged to contact Pitkin County Animal Control directly if they wish to report it.
